



## TREATY 8 FIRST NATIONS OF ALBERTA

### MOTION # 05-12-2014-02

WHEREAS T8FNA Education Commission have been mandated to develop a comprehensive education system and to fulfill their mandate resulted in three strategic planning sessions (September, October and November of 2014) which developed the proposed “Model for Delivery of Education in Treaty 8; and

WHEREAS the members from the Treaty No. 8 First Nations in Alberta who participated in the strategic planning sessions approved the model developed; and

WHEREAS the T8FNA Elders Council endorsed the model to be presented to the First Nations; and

Whereas the Executive Board of Chiefs passed this motion on March 27, 2014: “The Executive Board of Chiefs for Treaty 8 First Nations of Alberta endorse, in principal, the proposed “Model to Deliver Education in Treaty 8”, which outlines the general structure for governance and administration of a Treaty 8 education system. Further the proposed model can be presented, for feedback, to the membership of those First Nations whose Chief and Council permit T8FNA to do so.”

WHEREAS the Treaty 8 Chiefs of Alberta at a duly convened meeting held at the Marriot River Cree resort in Enoch Cree Nation on May 12, 2014 motioned:

1. Treaty 8 First Nations of Alberta (Education Department) to continue its work as per mandate and to work with the affiliated First Nations in moving forward with the implementation of the structure and process identified in the “Model for Delivery of Education in Treaty 8.
